WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

The Workforce Division was recently awarded over \$289,000 from the Commonwealth's WIOA Statewide Reserve Fund for its Work for Success program. The pilot program will work to improve skills while supporting the program partner's efforts to 'address the substance abuse problem.' For participants to be successful, the program will also work to educate the local business community on adaptive changes necessary to employ those with barriers to employment successfully. In addition, the program aims to improve Northern Kentuckians' lives, create direct employment pipelines for businesses struggling with employment shortages, and create resources for employers facing retainment concerns and high employee turnover rates.


