Why was this study done?

We know that this topic and ideas to address housing concerns have been occurring not only at NKADD and its partner organizations but across our region and our Commonwealth. At NKADD, the idea for a study originated in regional workforce development discussions with elected officials and planning commissions, Horizon Community Funds, CVG Airport, BE-NKY, Brighton Center, Kentucky Career Center/NKWIB and employers, as we work to better align employers needing talent with jobseekers.

Who funded the study?
