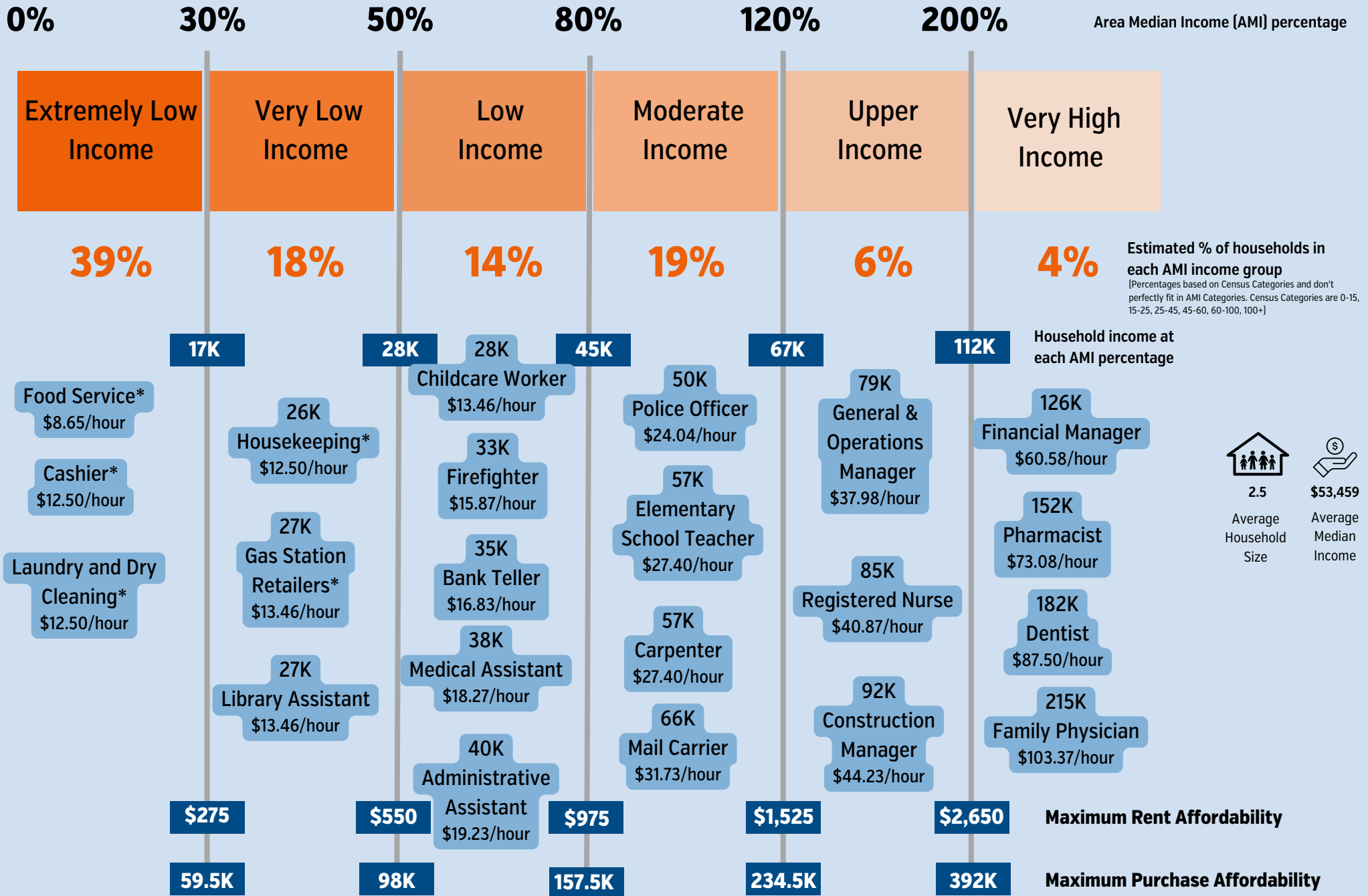


Distribution of Household Income & Affordability - Carroll County
