


### **AGING AND DISABILITY SERVICES**






### COMMODITIES

NKADD serves as the USDA Food Bank for the region's food pantries. Commodities, from The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) and the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP,) are distributed to individuals through partnerships with 42 food pantries, mobile pantries, and soup kitchens across the eight-county region.



TEFAP was utilized 3,288 times and CSFP was utilized 1,255 times in Pendleton County during FY 2025
